

## **Schedule**

Compliance with these conditions is mandatory under the *Heavy Vehicle National Law*.

Condition ID	Condition Description
001	The approval holder must notify the NHVR and all existing EWD approval holders (as listed on the NHVR website) of new IP addresses and public key details whenever a change or update to these details occurs.
002	The NHVR may amend rule sets. When this happens the NHVR will contact approval holders. Approval holders must ensure the correct versions of rule sets are operational within their EWD.
003	The approval holder shall undertake ongoing penetration testing to ensure that the EWD continues to be resistant to unauthorised technical interference and where a compromise of this nature is detected or suspected provide notification to the NHVR.
004	Upon cancellation of an approval by way of either approval holder request or NHVR initiation, the approval holder must cooperate fully after the point of exit to ensure appropriate data transfer occurs and that the cancellation is minimally disruptive to previous users of the EWD including complying with all outstanding record keeping requirements.
005	The approval holder must provide a statement to all drivers using the EWD regarding the way that rest time under 15 minutes is accounted for in the EWD. At a minimum the statement must include "rest time of under 15 minutes that does not satisfy a minimum rest requirement will not be added to your daily rest time total".
006	The approval holder may implement AFM rulesets (an implemented AFM ruleset) for use by drivers employed by a holder of AFM accreditation. A given implemented AFM ruleset must be specific to a given holder of AFM accreditation.
007	An implemented AFM ruleset may only be made available by Teletrac Navman to an AFM accreditation holder with the written approval of the Regulator. Any amendment of an implemented AFM ruleset must be approved by the regulator before being made available by Teletrac Navman.
008	Data regarding a driver's work and rest hours under an implemented AFM ruleset, or the conditions of a given holder of AFM accreditation must not be able to be shared with any other EWD technology provider at any time without prior approval from the NHVR.
009	If the operation of this implemented AFM ruleset differs in a specific way from the operation of a standard or BFM work set (for example; the AFM ruleset does not support peer to peer transfer of past records) or has any other particular requirements, instruction on these differences or requirements must be provided by Teletrac Navman to the user of the application.

## Change of details

This approval may be amended or cancelled on application by the approval holder, or by the NHVR pursuant to Chapter 6 of the HVNL. The NHVR must be notified as soon as is reasonable, of any changes to the electronic recording system to which this approval pertains.
