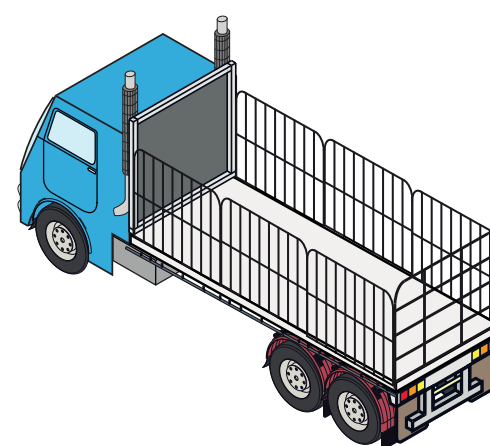




LOADING GUIDE SIDE GATES

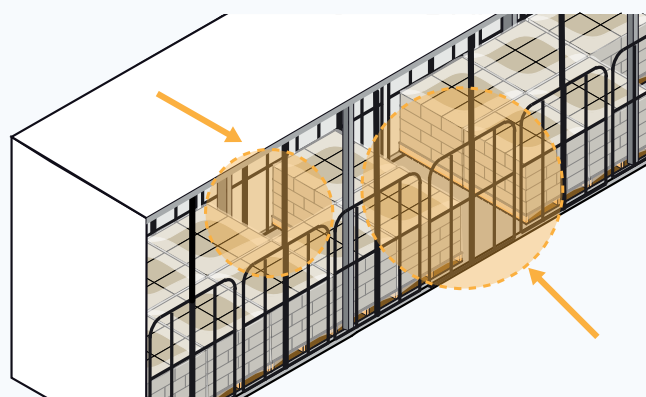
Side gates are permanent or removable vertical frames used at the sides of a vehicle's loading deck. They are generally made of steel and their load capacity will vary depending on the manufacturer and design. Some useful tips are:

- ✓ Unrated gates help to contain light loads only
- ✓ Do not stack loads above gates
- ✓ Gates are stronger when braced
- ✓ Use rated gates where possible
- ✓ Gates may be part of a certified restraint system.

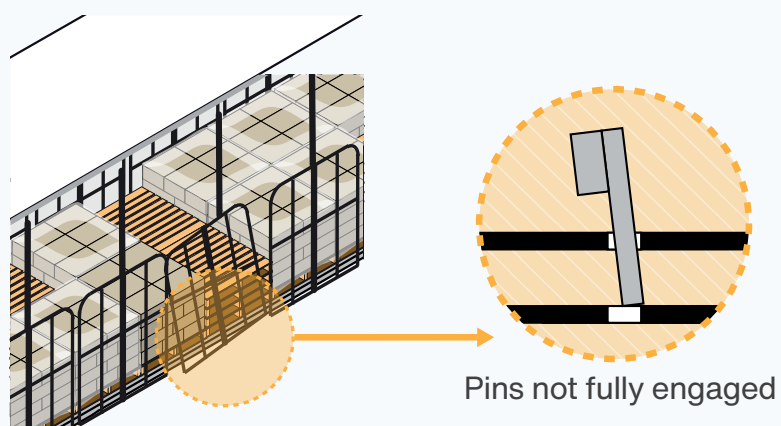

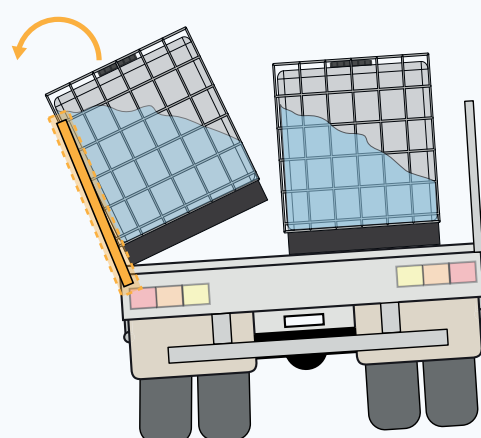
⚠ GAPS IN THE LOAD



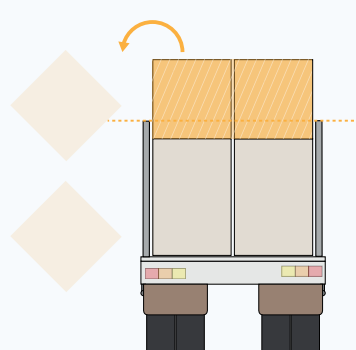
⚠ GATE NOT SECURE IN MOUNTING



⚠ GATE NOT BRACED

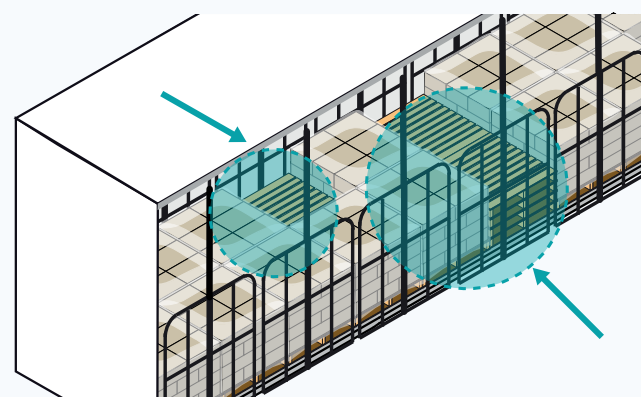


⚠ LOAD STACKED ABOVE GATE

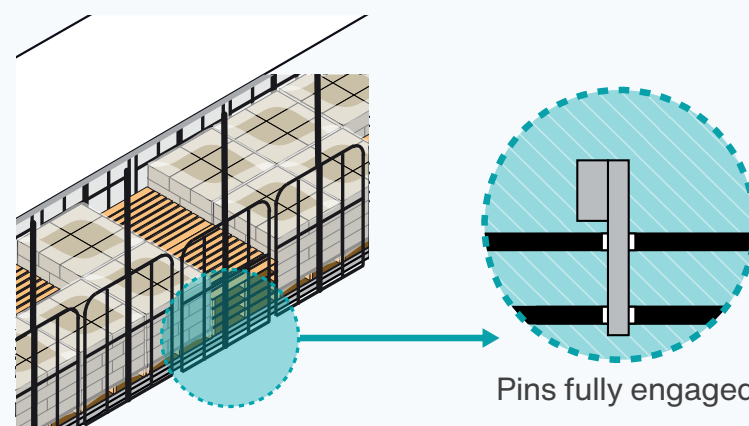

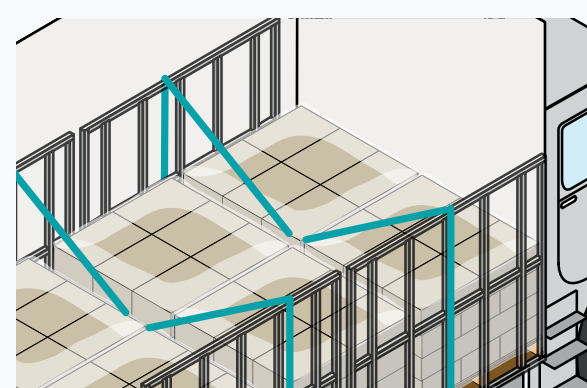
