


LOADING GUIDE PRE-TENSION



Pre-tension is the amount of clamping force a tensioner can apply to the load and is provided by the chain or webbing tensioner mechanism. Some useful tips are:

- O Different devices have different pre-tension
- Pre-tension is not the same as lashing capacity
- Select the correct LRG table based on pre-tension
- ✓ Poor clamping = poor pre-tension











GUESSING PRE-TENSION REQUIRED


