



LOADING GUIDE SHORING BARS



Shoring bars can be called many things from blocking bars or beams, to pogo sticks and the like. They are a high strength bar that can be spring loaded or have a ratchet mechanism that can be used to protect cargo and other loads when in transit.

- ✓ Only provide load restraint in the forwards and backwards direction
- ✓ Must be installed and used as per manufacturers instructions
- ✓ Are not suitable for all situations
- ✓ Must be replaced if damaged or worn




⚠ ONLY USING 1 SHORING BAR


✓ BLOCK EVERY 1 OR 2 ROWS
