

Schedule

Compliance with these conditions is mandatory under the Heavy Vehicle National Law.

Condition ID	Condition Description
001	The approval holder must notify the NHVR and all existing EWD approval holders (as listed on the NHVR website) of new IP addresses and public key details whenever a change or update to these details occurs.
002	The NHVR may amend rule sets. When this happens the NHVR will contact approval holders. Approval holders must ensure the correct versions of rule sets are operational within their EWD.
003	The approval holder shall undertake ongoing penetration testing to ensure that the EWD continues to be resistant to unauthorised technical interference and where a compromise of this nature is detected or suspected provide notification to the NHVR.
004	Upon cancellation of an approval by way of either approval holder request or NHVR initiation, the approval holder must cooperate fully after the point of exit to ensure appropriate data transfer occurs and that the cancellation is minimally disruptive to previous users of the EWD including complying with all outstanding record keeping requirements.
005	 This approval is only for the use of Netstar Australia EWD on the following devices: Garmin Fleet 7XX Series Samsung SM-T575 (known as the Samsung Galaxy Tab Active 3).

Change of details

The approval holder must notify the National Heavy Vehicle Regulator within 14 days of any change to approval holder details or any change to details of the electronic recording system to which this approval pertains.
