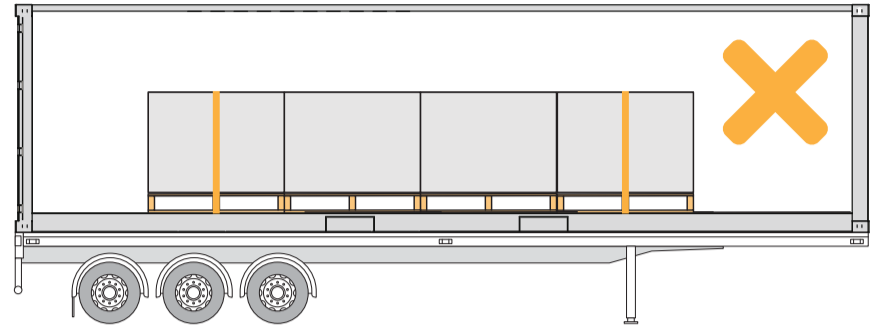




When restraining loads, it's important to think about what effect lashing only part of the load has on the entire load. Restraining only the first and last row means a single lashing has to prevent the movement of multiple rows.

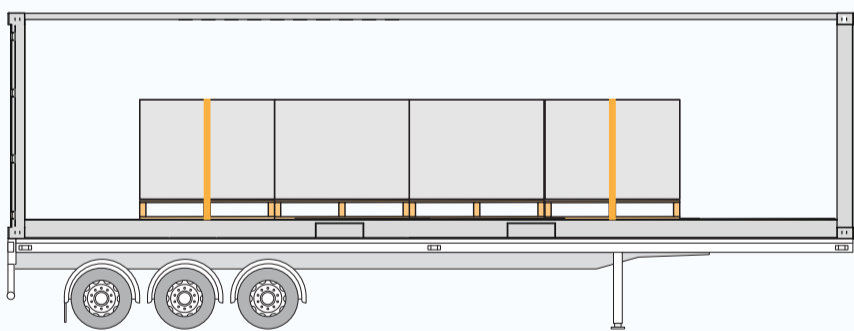
- ✔ Block loads where possible
- ✔ Blocking controls movement
- ✔ Blocked loads need less restraint
- ✔ Unblocked loads need more restraint

Note: always refer to the tables in the LRG for calculations



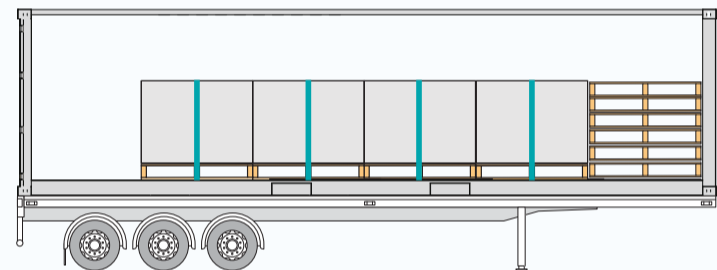

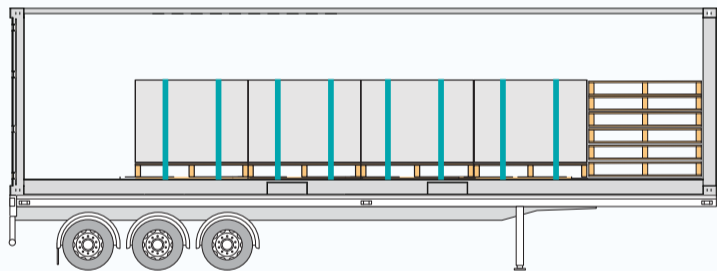

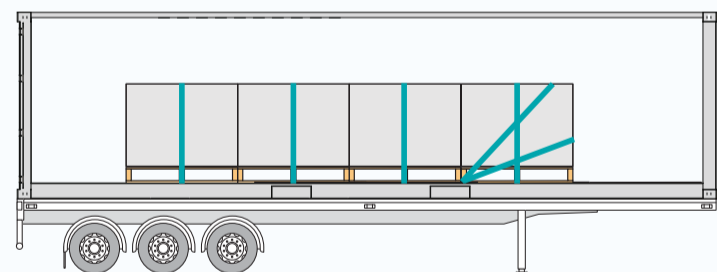
✔ STRAP EACH ROW



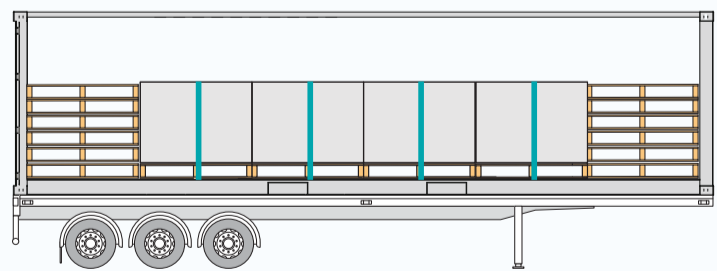
✔ DOUBLE STRAP EACH ROW
