Section 11 Engine, Driveline and Exhaust	Summary of changes
Version 2.1 February 2016	
11.1 Check exhaust system	Amended rejection reason (d) as follows:
	The exhaust outlet on a heavy motor vehicle, other than a bus, with a GVM exceeding 12 tonnes does not extend:
	• beyond the rear most seating position, and
	• at least 40mm past the outermost joint of the floor pan that is not continuously welded or permanently sealed, and
	• where the body of the vehicle is permanently enclosed and not fitted with a vertical exhaust system, to the edge of the vehicle.
	Note after rejection reason (e) removed.
	Instructions for measuring vehicle with can be found in Section 16 Vehicle Dimensions.
11.2 Check noise emissions	Introduction to the sub-section has been amended to include information on manually adjustable silencing devices. The web link to obtain a copy of the <i>National Exhaust Noise Test Procedures for In-Service Motor Vehicles</i> has been changed to the National Transport Commission webpage.
11.6 Visually inspect fire extinguisher	Corrected <i>Table 11.3 Fire Extinguisher requirements in accordance with AS 2444</i> by amending the heading in the second column from 'Maximum number of extinguishers' to 'Minimum number of extinguishers'.

16.1 Width	Amended the note at the end of the sub-section as follows:
	This is to be measured without taking into account any of the following:
	• anti-skid devices mounted on wheels
	• central tyre inflation systems
	• lights
	• rear vision mirrors
	• reflectors
	• signalling devices
	• tyre pressure gauges
	• permanently fixed webbing assembly-type devices, such as curtain side devices, if the maximum width across the vehicle and including the devices, does not exceed 2.55 metres.
