### Victoria Class 3 Heavy Vehicle Livestock Carrier Mass Exemption Notice 2016 (No. 1)

#### Purpose

The purpose of the *Victoria Class 3 Heavy Vehicle Livestock Carrier Mass Exemption Notice 2016 (No.1)* is to exempt a stated category of class 3 heavy vehicles from mass requirements in the *Heavy Vehicle (Mass Dimension and Loading) National Regulation*.

#### Introduction

- This Notice replaces Victoria Class 3 Heavy Vehicle Livestock Carrier Mass Exemption Notice 2015 (No.1).
- This Notice is being extended for three years and the commencement date and operational period has been amended. No other changes have been made to this Notice.

#### Period of Operation

This Notice commences on 10 November 2016 and expires on 9 November 2019.

#### Type of Vehicle

This notice applies to a 'livestock carrier' which means a heavy vehicle or combination that is up to 4.6 metres high and that is built to carry cattle, sheep, pigs or horses.

#### Area of Operation

A vehicle operating under this Notice may use the areas or routes as set out below:

TYPE OF VEHICLE	ALLOWABLE AREAS OR ROUTES
Any Livestock carrier	All arterial roads in Victoria
A livestock carrier that is a combination consisting of a prime mover and a semitrailer	All roads in Victoria
A livestock carrier that is a B-double combination	A declared B-double route

## Conditions

A vehicle operating under this Notice is subject to conditions set out in Schedules 1, 2 and 3. The conditions included in the schedules include information on:

- Unladen Mass of prime movers, semi-trailers, B-doubles;
- Dimension limits;
- Axle spacing;
- Operating conditions.
