# South Australia Class 3 Long Prime Mover Combination Exemption Notice 2018

## **Purpose**


The purpose of this information sheet is to introduce a new notice titled South Australia Class 3 Long Prime Mover Combination Exemption Notice 2018 (the Notice).

This notice allows prime movers which have been designed to haul road trains to tow single semi-trailer and still meet certain dimensions required for access on established networks.

#### What vehicles are covered?


The new Notice allows the following combinations to operate in South Australia:

### Prime mover and semitrailer combination



Dimension	Limit (m)
Length (L)	19.0 ≤ L < 20.0
Height	4.3
Width	2.5

## Prime mover, semitrailer and converter dolly combination.



Dimension	Limit (m)
Length (L)	L < 26.0
Height	4.3
Width	2.5

Please note: the converter dolly may have up to 3 axles.

#### Stated Network

An eligible semi-trailer combination operating under this notice may only access the following network(s):

- South Australia 26 metre B-double Network (GML & HML)
- 26.0m B-double Commodity Network (GML & HML)

An eligible semi-trailer and converter dolly combination operating under this notice may only access the following network:

South Australia Road Train Convertor Dolly Network (GML & HML)

### **Conditions**

- The prime mover has a Registration configuration code for a three axle prime mover hauling two or three trailers
- The trailers comply otherwise with the relevant section of the MDL regulation.
