1 Authorising provision

This Notice is made under:

- a) Section 175 of the Heavy Vehicle National Law as applied in each participating jurisdiction.

2 Purpose

The purpose of this Notice is to amend stated maps for vehicles at the request of road managers.

3 Commencement Date

The amendments take effect immediately.

4 Title

This Notice may be cited as the Heavy Vehicle Stated Maps – Amendment Notice 2019 (No.3)

5 Application

This Notice applies in all participating jurisdictions.

6 Amendments
